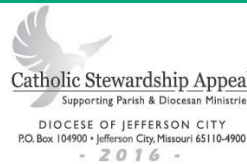
75% of CRS Rice Bowl donations help the poor overseas, and 25% support local hunger and poverty alleviation projects in our diocese.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY, JANUARY 18-25

“But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God’s people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.” (1 Peter 2: 9-10)

The biblical text for the 2016 theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity; “Called to Proclaim the Mighty Acts of the Lord.”

St. Peter tells the early Church that in their search for meaning prior to encountering the Gospel they were not a people. But through hearing the call to be God’s chosen race and receiving the power of God’s salvation in Jesus Christ, they have become God’s people. This reality is expressed in Baptism, common to all Christians, in which we are born again of water and the Holy Spirit (cf. John 3:5). In baptism we die to sin, in order to rise with Christ to a new life of grace in God. It is an ongoing challenge daily to remain aware of this new identity in Christ. How do we understand our common call to be “God’s people”? How do we express our baptismal identity as a “royal priesthood”?
