Please use the envelopes for the Catholic Missourian that is in your monthly packet to pay your subscription. The cost is \$14 per year. The bill for the Cathedral last year was \$18,410. We expect the bill to be the same this year. So far we have only collected \$4,135.00 this year! The remainder will have to be paid from general revenue which takes away from extra social projects and school events. Please help us!

## HOLY MASS INTENTION'S EXPLAINED

What does it mean to have Mass "offered" for someone? An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person, or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Infinite graces flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass to benefit one's soul. The tradition of offering Masses for others originates in the very early Church. When a priest offers Holy Mass, he has three intentions: First, to offer the Mass reverently and validly in accord with the norms of the Church. Second, to offer the Mass in union with the whole Church and for the good of the whole Church. Third, to offer the Mass for a particular intention, such as the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Therefore, the effects of the Mass bring certain benefits or fruits. The general fruits of the Mass are the effects upon the whole Church to the living faithful as well as the poor souls in purgatory. For this reason, in the Eucharistic Prayer, a special mention is made for both the living and the dead. If you would like to have a Mass offered for someone, please come to the Parish Office. The stipend is \$5 per Mass and there is a quantity restriction per intention due to the large number of requests here.

## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Our Gospel Reading for today finishes with the Lord telling us, "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will save it." That may sound somewhat foreboding to us as we strive to follow Him and to be His disciple.

We need to see that from another perspective, however. Jesus was fond of teaching by using references to plants and planting. On multiple occasions he cites seeds in His teachings. If we consider it, we bury a seed; in effect it dies. Nevertheless, it must die for it to fulfill what it was intended to be. It cannot produce fruit, become a tree unless it goes through the process of dying to what it once was.

That is Jesus' message for us. If we truly wish to follow Him, we must die to what we once may have been, or in some cases to what we may think we want to be. We have to learn to look at ourselves as the Lord might look at us. The ongoing question is "What does the Lord want me to be?" or "How does the Lord want me to serve Him and others?"

It is not easy to serve the Lord. It is not comfortable to always think of others first. Yet, those are Jesus' instructions to us. That is His call to us. As He reminded us many times, "I came to serve, not to be served." That needs to be our goal as well. That is what stewardship is all about.

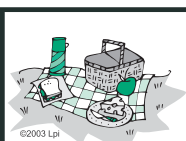
