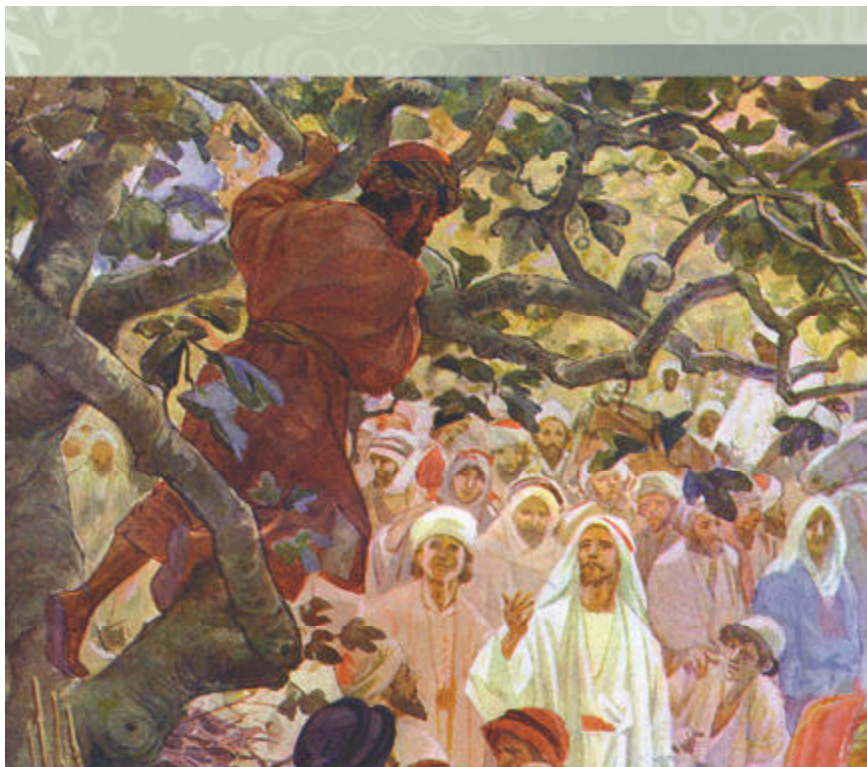

## PARISH INFORMATION

### Sacrament of Baptism

Parents requesting the Sacrament of Baptism for their children should be registered members of the Parish. Parents should try to see that their children are baptized within the first few weeks after birth. A baptism preparation session is required for new parents. Contact Deacon Baker via the Parish Office to set an appointment.

### Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

Parishioners facing surgery or struggling with serious illness may request this Sacrament of healing by calling a priest at the Parish Office.

### Holy Matrimony

Call the Parish Office and schedule a meeting with a clergy member. During the initial meeting, you can set a wedding date. Only after speaking with a priest can a date be Confirmed. The wedding date should be at least 6 months after the first meeting. A couple must be free to marry in the Catholic Church. If either person has been previously married, no date can be set until their freedom to marry has been determined.

**Cookie Dough Recipe:**

Combine: 2 3/4 cups flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt.  
Cream until light and fluffy: 3/4 cup soft butter (not whipped or tub margarine), 1 cup sugar, 2 eggs, 1 teaspoon vanilla. Add dry ingredients to creamed mixture. Blend thoroughly. Chill 1 hour until firm. Bring your cookie dough to the Undercroft refrigerator on **Nov. 3**.
