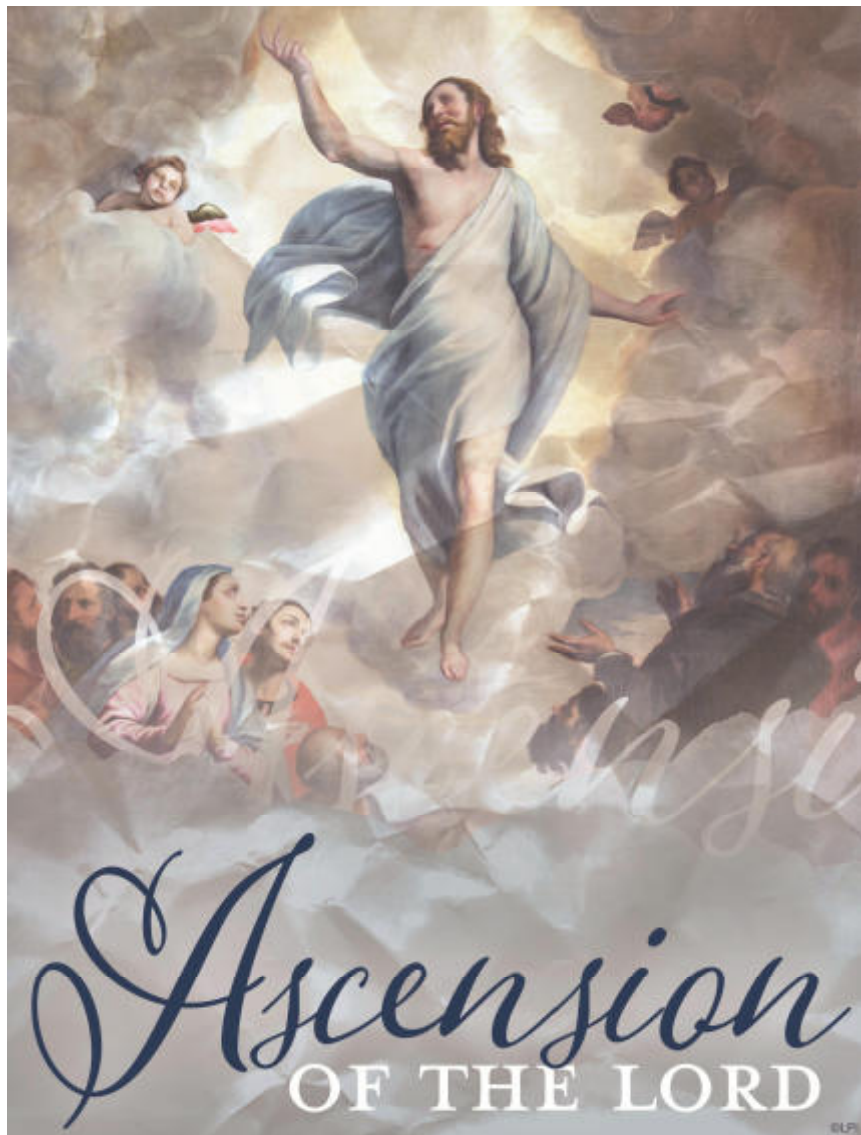

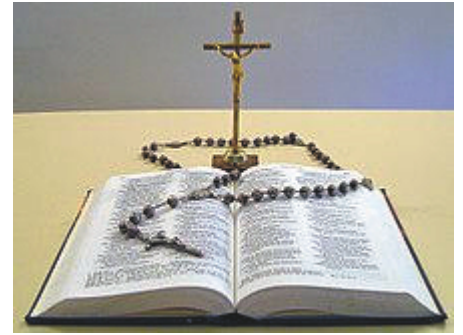

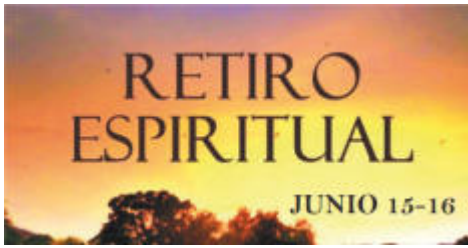
"WINE & SHRINE" EVENTS
